

13. KHMER COMMUNITY ADVISORY GROUP

A Khmer Community Advisory Group is a body of up to seven people who act as a community resource and can be called on as needed to support the Association and the work of the Central Management Committee.

- a The Advisory Group shall comprise Association members who are recognised as having commitment, experience and expertise necessary for the development of the Association.
- b The members of an Advisory Group are appointed by acceptance of nomination from members at the Annual General Meeting of the Association in the non-election year.
- c The Advisory Group's role is:
 - i providing advice, as needed, to the Central Management Committee, severally or collectively on issues arising within the community;
 - ii assisting the Central Management Committee in developing policies, priorities, plans and good governance for the Khmer Community;
 - iii representing issues affecting the community;
 - iv communicating and sharing information with the membership;
 - v supporting mediation of internal disputes involving members;
 - vi assisting in determining the outcome of disciplinary matters involving members.
- d The Advisory Group shall meet together by agreement from time to time with the Central Management Committee to discuss issues and give advice, provided that no more than six months shall elapse between the meetings.

- e The Advisory Group shall also meet separately to dispatch of business, adjourn and otherwise appoint and regulate its business as it thinks fit. The Group is facilitated by a Convenor appointed by the group for a two-year period until the next AGM. The Convenor and any members of the Group may at any time call a meeting of the Group.
