13. KHMER COMMUNITY ADVISORY GROUP

A Khmer Community Advisory Group is a body of up to seven people who act as a community resource and can be called on as needed to provide advice and support to the Central Management Committee of the Khmer Community of NSW.

The Advisory Group shall comprise Association members who are recognised as having commitment, experience and expertise necessary for the development of the Association.

The members of the Advisory Group are selected by Association members according to nominations received and presented by the Central Management Committee at the Annual General Meeting of the Association in the non-election year.

a. The Advisory Group's role is:

- i providing advice, as requested or needed, to the Central Management Committee, individually or collectively on issues arising within the community;
- ii assisting the Central Management Committee in developing policies, priorities, plans and good governance for the Khmer Community;
- iii raising issues affecting the community with the Central Management Committee;
- iv communicating and sharing information with the membership through the Central Management Committee;
- v supporting the Central Management Committee in mediating internal disputes and managing disciplinary matters involving members;

b. The Advisory Group shall meet together by agreement from time to time with the Central Management Committee to discuss issues and give advice, provided that no more than six months shall elapse between the meetings.

c. The Advisory Group shall also meet separately to discuss issues, and organise its business relating to its role as it thinks fit. The Group is facilitated by a Convenor appointed by the Group for a two-year period until the next AGM. The Convenor and any members of the Group may at any time call a meeting of the Group.
